1. President
2. Secretary-Treasurer
3. Industrial/Retail/Offshore Vice-President

Executive Board Members for the geographic area/sector in which you work, as per the following:

4. One Executive Board member to be elected representing fish plant workers from Cape Freels south to Cape Pine, inclusive;

5. One Executive Board member to be elected representing fish plant workers from Cape Pine West to Cox's Cove, inclusive.
6. One Executive Board member to be elected representing fish plant workers from Labrador, the Northern Peninsula, and that portion of the Northeast coast from Jackson's Arm to Cape Freels, inclusive.
7. One Executive Board member to be elected who works in a non-fishing related industrial unit.
8. One Executive Board member to be elected who works at sea to represent the offshore units of the Industrial/Retail/Offshore Division.
9. One Executive Board member to be elected to the Women's position to represent women members in the Industrial/Retail/Offshore Division.

Note: Nominators must be members of the constituency which the nominee seeks to represent.

The Industrial/Retail/Offshore Women's position was established to ensure our Industrial/Retail/Offshore women members are represented on our Executive Board. Only Industrial/Retail/Offshore women members are eligible to nominate and run for this position. The election of this Women's position will take place at the Constitutional Convention. **Note: the nomination period for this position is May 9 to May 28, 2018.**
